As we begin this undertaking, it is important to get ideas from those who know Deadwood best, YOU!

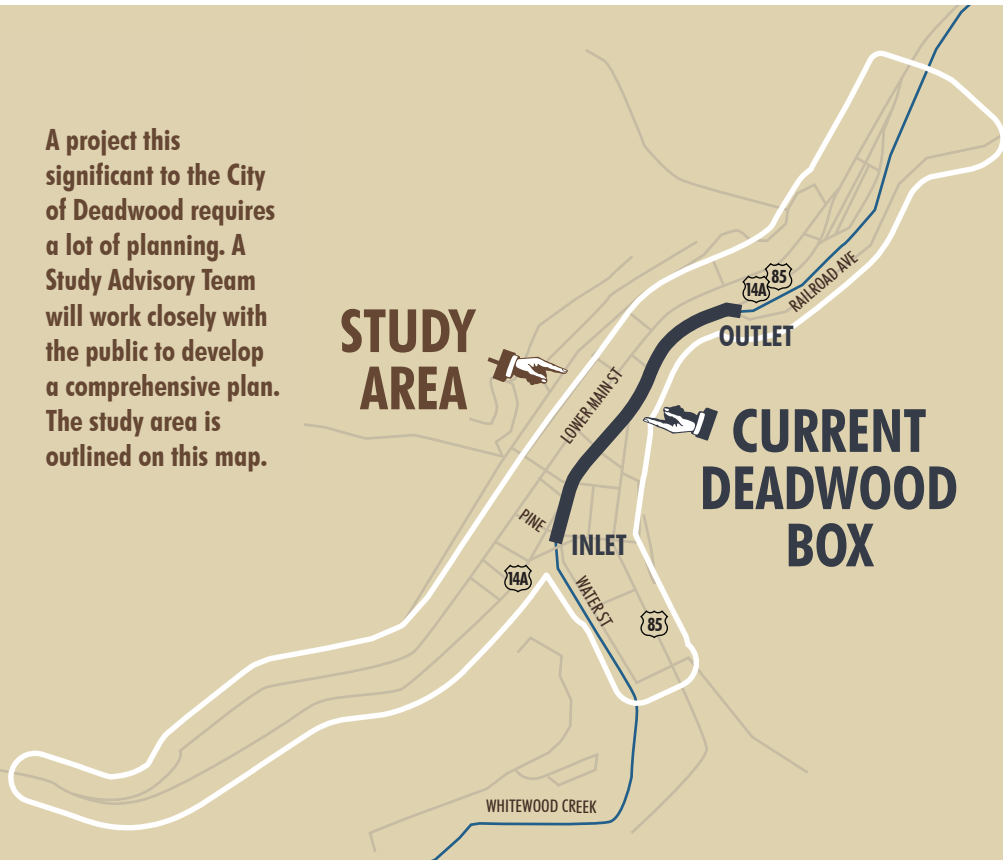
